Unfinished Business:

- A. Denied Building Permit:** Mayor Hollerich shared with the council that the Zoning Board met on September 16th to discuss Sandra Danberry's building permit for the swing set she built in the city's right of way. In a unanimous vote, it was decided that Danberry has 60 days to move the swing set off the city's property and after 60 days, she will be fined daily. Clerk Duncanson noted that in the letter she sent she stated that public works will assist in finding her property lines if she would like.

New Business

- A. Resolution 64-09-20 Televising & Cleaning Sewer Lines:** Public Works has received a quote from Empire Pipe Service to clean and inspect approximately 7,000 linear feet of sanitary sewer mains at a price of \$1.30 /LF. This vendor has been used in the past and this is budgeted for. **Councilor Warner moved and Councilor Froehlich seconded to adopt Resolution 64-09-20 approving the cleaning and televising of sewer mains at an estimated cost of \$9,960. Roll Call Vote: Aye: Froehlich, Christian, Maslakow, Warner, Hollerich. Nay: none. Motion carried.**
- B. Resolution 65-09-20 Delinquent Accounts:** Clerk Duncanson shared the list of delinquent accounts for 2020. These accounts will be certified to the Blue Earth County Land Records Office for

collection in 2021 and an 8% interest rate will be levied against the accounts. **Councilor Christian moved and Councilor Maslakow seconded to adopt Resolution 65-09-20 approving the Certification of Delinquent Accounts for Tax Levy Collectible in 2021. Roll Call Vote: Aye: Froehlich, Christian, Maslakow, Warner, Hollerich. Nay: none. Motion Carried**

Councilor Froehlich moved and Councilor Christian seconded to adjourn the meeting. All present voted in favor thereof. Motion carried. Mayor Hollerich adjourned the meeting at 7:05p.m.
